- (c) the number of cases reported during each of the last three years and the current year, State-wise; and
- (d) the remedial/precautionary measures taken/being taken in this regard?

(a) to (d): Some reports in the media on occupational diseases due to exposure to red dust in iron ore mining areas had come to the notice of the Government.
