## Will the Minister of PETROLEUM AND NATURAL GAS be pleased to state:

(a) Whether a fall has been registered in the net profit of Oil and Natural Gas Corporation, a public sector undertaking during the year 2008-09, 2009-10;

(b) if so, the reasons therefor; and

(c) the steps being taken by the Government to compensate the losses of the company?

## Answer

(a) Yes Madam.

(b) The reasons for decrease in net profit of Oil and Natural Gas Corporation Limited (ONGC) in the year 2008-09 as compared to 2007-08 are as under:

(i) More subsidy sharing to Oil Marketing Companies (OMCs) on account of high volatility in oil prices.

(ii) Increase in the cost of input oil field services and materials.

(iii) Increase in cost of drilling, survey and production during the year.

(iv) Increase in exchange rate of US \$ to Indian Rupee by about 14% over the previous year.

(v) Additional demand of profit petroleum in respect of Ravva Joint Venture etc.

(c) No losses have been suffered by the company, only a fall in the net profit has been registered.
