CONSTRUCTION WORK ON NH-6

Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of the construction work for four laning of NH-6 being undertaken by the National Highways Authority of India (NHA) and the time by which the same is targeted to be completed;
- (b) whether the construction work on several stretches on the said NH has been delayed;
- (c) if so, the details thereof alongwith the reasons therefor, stretch-wise;
- (d) whether the Government/NHA has taken any action against the defaulting contractors;
- (e) if so, the details thereof, stretchwise and the penalty imposed against each contractor;
- (f) whether care has been taken in the design of the said NH to cater to the heavy industrial traffic plying on it; and
- (g) if so, the details thereof and the action taken in this regard alongwith the number of bridges constructed/proposed to be constructed on the said NH?

Answer

(a) to (c) Details of stretches on NH-6 taken up for 4-laning by National Highways Authority of India (NHA) are enclosed as Annex-I. Out of six projects under implementation, two projects have been delayed. The projects have been delayed due to delay in land acquisition and delay in clearance for Road over Bridge (ROB).

(d) & (e) Does not arise.

(f) to (g) Yes, Sir. Roads under National Highways Development Project (NHDP) are constructed as per Indian Roads Congress (IRC) / Ministry of Road Transport & Highways (MoRT&H) specifications. The number of bridges in various stretches on NH-6 with NHA is enclosed as Annex-II.
