STATEMENT

Statement referred to in reply to parts (a), (b), (c) and (d) of the Lok Sabha Starred Question No. 503 for answer on 30.4.2010 regarding Bio -Energy Technology.

- (a): Yes Madam.
- (b): A Project on "Removal of Barriers to Biomass Power Generation in India" assisted by United Nations Development Programme (UNDP) / Global Environment Facility (GEF) is being implemented by the Ministry with the objective to identify barriers in large scale commercialization of biomass power. The project inter-alia involves establishment of 7-10 Model Investment Projects (MIPs) in different parts of the country with the view to demonstrate the viability of investment and financing models for mainstreaming the biomass sector. The UNDP / GEF contribution for the project is US \$ 5.65 million whereas Government of India contribution is US \$ 5.24 million. The project is scheduled for completion in March, 2012.
- (c)&(d): Expressions of Interest (EOI) have been obtained from biomass power project developers to select and support setting up of Model Investment Projects (MIPs) after evaluation.
