(a)to(c): National Food for Work Programme (NFWP) was launched in 150 selected districts in the country in November, 2004. The programme was introduced as a prelude to National Rural Employment Guarantee Act and was subsumed in the Act with effect from 2.2.2006. Under NFWP, 785.18 lakh mandays of employment was generated during the year 2004-05 and 3043.56 lakh mandays were generated during 2005-06.
