Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Total Sanitation Campaign (TSC) is running satisfactorily in the country including Uttar Pradesh;
- (b) if so, whether any directions have been issued to the State Governments for removing shortcomings and for successful implementation of the said campaign;
- (c) if so, the details thereof;
- (d) whether the prize money has been released to winner `Gram Sabhas` of the last year under `Nirmal Gram Puraskar Yojana` in the country including Uttar Pradesh;
- (e) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor; and
- (f) the time by which the said prize money is to be released to the winners?

Answer

MINISTER OF THE STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT (MS. AGATHA SANGMA)

- (a) Yes sir. Sanitation Coverage in Rural area was 1% in 1981 which went up to only 22% as per census 2001. The percentage has gone up to 62.12% as per the latest available figures reported by the states through on line monitoring system of Total Sanitation Campaign (TSC).
- (b) and (c) Do not arise.
- (d)to(f) The award money for the last year has been released to the respective States including Uttar Pradesh for distribution of the same to the Gram Panchayats that have been awarded 'Nirmal Gram Puraskar' (NGP). A statement indicating details of release of Award Money to the respective States is annexed.
