(a) to (d): Oil & Natural Gas Corporation Limited (ONGC), a Government of India Undertaking has signed an Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with MOL, Hungarian Oil arid Gas P!c. on 18th January, 2008 for cooperate on and joint participation in Exploration & Production (E&P) sector in India and abroad, exchange of basic and applied Research & Development (R&D) information, transfer of technology in upstream and downstream sectors, and cooperation in respect of training and human resource development activities. ONGC has also signed a Farm-out Agreement for assignment of 35% Participating Interest (PI) in exploration block HF-ONN-2001/1 located in Himalayan Foothills with BMN Investment Limited, a fully owned subsidiary of MOL Hungarian Oil and Gas Pic. on 8th May, 2008.
