(a)&(b): National Crime Records Bureau (NCRB) data shows rising trend in incidence of violence against women and children. Incidence of crime against women and children during 2006, 2007 & 2008 are given in Annexure I and II respectively.

(c),(d)&(e): The Government has a proposal to amend the Dowry Prohibition Act, 1961 and Indecent Representation of Women (Prohibition) Act, 1986 with a view to strengthen them. The Government has set up a High Level Committee to look into amendments to the provisions of the Indian Penal Code.
