(a) and (b): No, Madam. The Government of India extends the single default guarantee to FCI for availing cash credit from consortium of banks as per the norms fixed by the RBI since it is a Central Government agency managed by the food subsidy bills of the Government. The similar guarantee is not extended to agencies of State Government/UT Administrations as their finances are controlled by their respective State Government/UT Administrations and they are responsible for their independent role in procurement of foodgrains for the Central Pool.
