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BOOKING OF LPG THROUGH SMS

- (b) & (c): Public Sector Oil Marketing Companies (OMCs) have introduced Short Message Service (SMS) booking in some distributors across the country. Further, this facility is proposed to be introduced in all towns with the population of 5 lakh by the year 2015 in phases beginning with metros.
