The objective of the Advisory Committee was to advise the Planning Commission on strategies and the nature of schemes that could be implemented in the States in order to optimize the potentiality, which exists in the country. After visits to different States and UTs, and interactions made with officials concerned, the Advisory Committee has made State-wise specific recorn mendations on crucial schemes ai id projects and suggested streamlined procedure for their implementation.

The Government welcomes the recommendations of the Committee and supports their implementation, as appropriate, in due course.
