- (a) whether several State Government including Bihar and Karnataka have submitted proposal under the Fodder Development Scheme for development of fodder, grasslands/ meadows;
- (b) if so, the details thereof, State-wise; and
- (c) the time by which such proposals are likely to finalized and funds released to the States for fodder development?

## **Answer**

- (a) to (b) Yes, Madam. Several States except Bihar have submitted the proposal for fodder development under Centrally Sponsored Fodder Development Scheme The status of proposals submitted and funds released during 2009-IOto the States is given at Annexture.
- (c) The Department has modified the ongoing Centrally Sponsored Fodder Development Scheme to include changes in funding pattern/eligibility criteria of some components and six new components for implementation during 2010-11. Hence State Government will have to submit fresh proposals under the new scheme for release of funds during 2010-11.
