- (b) The stretch from Shimoga to Mangalore on NH-13 for a length of 188 km. has been identified under NHDP Phase IV-A. The other stretch from Hospet-Chitradurga on NH-13 for a length of 119 km. has been identified under NHDP Phase-IVB. The stretch from Ankola-Hubli-Hospet-Bellary-Gotty on NH-63 for a length of 421 km has been identified under NHDP Phase-IVB and has been transferred recently to NHAI for implementation.
