Will the Minister of COMMUNICATIONS AND INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Bharat Sanchar Nigam Limited (BSNL) is functioning without a financial advisor for more than a year due to delay in selection procedure,

(b) if so, the reasons therefore alongwith its impact on the working of the company;

(c) whether the Public Enterprises Selection Board had started the process in November 2008 and yet the final appointment is pending;

(d) if so, the details thereof; and

(e) the steps taken/being taken by the Government in this regard?

Answer

(a) to (e): The post of DirectorfFinance), BSNL, which fell vacant on 21-12-2008, was advertised by Public Enterprises Selection Board (PSEB) on 05-11-2008. That Board, through its communication dated 10-02-2009, recommended Smt. Anita Soni, Director (Finance), Mahanagar Telephone Nigam Limited (MTNL), and Shri T R Gandhi, General Manager, MTNL, in order of preference, for appointment to the post. Smt. Anita Soni was, however, found not to fulfill educational qualification prescribed for the post. A proposal recommending appointment of Shri T R Gandhi was not approved by the competent authority. PESB has advertised the post of Director (Finance), BSNL again on 19-03-2010. Charge of the post of Director (Finance), BSNL was entrusted to Director (HRD), BSNL, in addition to his own charge, upto 20-06-2009. Thereafter, the charge of the post vests in Chairman and Managing Director, BSNL.
