- (a): the details of funds allocated/released so far during the Eleventh Five Year Plan under various welfare schemes for women and children in the country, Scheme-wise;
- (b): whether the funds allocated/released are sufficient to achieve targets fixed under the said schemes during the above Plan period;
- (c): if not, whether the Government proposes to enhance the allocation of funds under the said schemes; and
- (d): if so, the details thereof?

Answer

- (a): Scheme-wise funds allocated /released under the various welfare schemes for women and children during the first three years of the Eleventh Five Year Plan (2007-08, 2008-09 and 2009-10) are given in the Annual Reports of the Ministry which are available in the Library of Lok Sabha Secretariat. The scheme-wise budgetary provision for the current year i.e. 2010-11, the 4th year of the Eleventh Five Year Plan, is annexed.
- (b), (c) & (d): The allocation for the Ministry is Rs 11000 crores, for the year 2010-11 an increase of around 50% over last year's BE of Rs 7350 crores. Within this overall allocation to the Ministry, funds are allocated/released for different schemes keeping in mind the requirement of the scheme and target fixed. Thus, most of the schemes of the Ministry are getting enhanced funds during 2010-11.
