MINISTER OF THE STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF LAW AND JUSTICE (DR. M, VEERAPPA MOILY)

(a),(b)& (c): Bringing in a Uniform Civil Code necessarily involves changes in the Personal Laws including those of the minority communities. It has been the consistent policy of the Central Government not to interfere in the Personal Laws of the minority communities unless the necessary initiatives for such changes come from a sizeable cross-section of communities themselves. At present, there is no specific proposal to bring Uniform Civil Code in the country.
