- (a) whether the present charges/fees for obtaining ISI certificates for the small scale industries is very high making it very difficult for Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSMEs) to obtain the certification;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the reasons therefor;
- (c) whether the Government proposes to reduce the charges or exempt the MSMEs for such charges to promote such enterprises; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

Answer

- (a) & (b): The present charges /fees for obtaining ISI certification for the small scale industries are not high. Minimum marking fee is worked out by Bureau of Indian Standards (BIS) based on the actual expenses likely to be incurred by it in the operation of a license. However, BIS is giving a lump-sum concession in minimum marking fee to the units registered as small scale industry for obtaining licenses.
