STATEMENT REFERRED IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) TO (e) OF LOK SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO.264 FOR 16.03.2010 REGARDING PRICES 01 ESSENTIAL COMMODITIES IN INTERNATIONAL MARKET.

(a) & (b): The domestic and international prices of most essential commodities are generally moving in tandem. Details are at Annexure I.

(c): The recent fall in international prices has been accompanied by a decline in domestic prices.

(d): Government has formulated schemes/action plan including curb on demand from bulk consumers, shoring up of supply and rejuvenating distribution system in order to control prices.

(e): Details of steps taken by the Government are listed in Annexure II. Prices of most essential commodities have either declined or have been steady in the last three months as is evident from Annexure III.
