(a) to (c) This Department is operating Assistance to States for Developing Export Infrastructure and Allied Activities (ASIDE) Scheme as per two components. 80% of total funds (State Component) available under ASIDE for disbursement are allocated amongst all States/UTs on the basis of an allocation criteria. Balance 20% is retained at Central Level (Central Component) for taking up the projects related to Special Economic Zones (SEZs), Central Agencies and inter-State projects. At this point of time no proposal to review criteria for allocation of funds to Land Locked States under ASIDE Scheme is pending with this Department.
