Will the Minister of PERSONNEL, PUBLIC GRIEVANCES AND PENSIONS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether technical/professional degree holders are increasing in the All India Services and other Central Services over the years;
- (b) if so, the details thereof, during the last two years and the current year;
- (c) whether the officers are making optimum use of their technical knowledge in their areas of jurisdiction by taking up capacity building projects and organize short-term courses in some institutions; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and the outcome thereto?

Answer

(a)&(b): All India Services comprise of Indian Administrative Service (IAS), Indian Police Service (IPS) and Indian Forest Service (IFoS). Officers of Indian Forest Service are recruited through Indian Forest Service Examination where the eligibility condition itself is minimum graduation in Science/Agriculture/ Forestry subjects and most of the recruits are technical and professional degree holders. Civil Services Examination (CSE) is conducted annually by UPSC for various Services including the other two All India Services i.e. IAS and IPS. As per information available with UPSC, the number of Engineers (B.E., B.Tech, B.Sc(Engg-), M.Tech etc.) and Doctors (MBBS, BDS, BIMS, MD etc) recommended during the last three years were as under:-
