GUIDELINES FOR PROMOTION OF SPORTS

Will the Minister of YOUTH AFFAIRS AND SPORTS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Union Government has issued any guidelines to the State Governments with regard to the promotion/development of sports in the country; and
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the reaction of the State Governments on such guidelines?

Answer

MINISTER OF THE STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF YOUTH AFFAIRS AND SPORTS (SHRI PRATIK PRAKASHBAPU PATIL)

(a) & (b): Sports is a State subject. Primary responsibility for development and promotion of sports is that of States. However, for supplementing the efforts of the States, the Ministry of Youth Affairs &Sports and the Sports Authority of India are implementing a number of schemes. In 2008-09, the Government has introduced a nation-wide centrally sponsored scheme titled "Panchayat Yuva Krida aur Khel Abhiyan" (PYKKA) with the aim of broad-basing of sports by way of creation of basic sports facilities in all village panchayats and block panchayats in a phased manner over a ten year period and by providing access to organized sports competitions at block, district, state and national level. Further, the Government has set up in 2009 a National Playing Fields Association of India (NPFAI) with the objective of promoting, preserving and protecting playfields. The Ministry has asked the States to set up similar bodies at State level.
