(a), (b) & (c) An earlier proposal received from the State (Karnataka) in this regard was not considered, since declaration of new tiger reserves was not viewed favorably in the 38th meeting of the Steering Committee of Project Tiger held on 12.4.2005. Subsequently, based on a communication received in December, 2008, the State was advised to send a revised proposal vis-Ã -vis the provisions of the Wildlife (Protection) Act, 1972, besides the landscape / ecological parameters, which has since been received for consideration by the National Tiger Conservation Authority.
