- (a) the number of flood forecasting centres in the country, State-wise;
- (b) whether the Government proposes to open more such centres in the flood prone areas of the country;

- (d) the funds allocated and released for setting up such centres during the last three years and the current year, State-wise and year-wise?

- (a) Central Water Commission (CWC) issues flood forecasts for 175 Stations in the country. The flood forecasts are formulated at 21 Flood Forecasting Centres. The State-wise details of Flood Forecast Stations and Flood Forecasting Centres of Central Water Commission are enclosed as Annexure-I and Annexure-II. In addition, a central control room is operated at CWC Headquarter, New Delhi during flood season.
