- (a) & (b) As ASEAN Chair, Vietnam will host 17th ASEAN Summit and related meeting in Hanoi, Vietnam in October 2010. It has been our practice to participate in these meetings at the appropriate levels. Our Prime Minister is expected to visit Hanoi in October in connection with India-ASEAN Summit/East Asia Summit.
- (c) to (e) India has close and traditional ties with Vietnam. Within the framework of their strategic partnership, the two countries enjoy strong political, economic, trade, defence, cultural, scientific, educational and cultural relations. During Prime Minister's visit, we hope to deepen these ties.
