Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of Private Colleges/Institutions which were granted deemed University status by the Union Government during the last three years, year-wise and State -wise;
- (b) whether there were irregularities in according sanction and providing grant to the deemed Universities;
- (c) if so, whether the Government would get the matter inquired through an independent agency: and
- (d) if so, the time by which the final decision is likely to be taken?

(a): The Central Government, on the advice of the University Grants Commission (UGC), declared thirty five non-government institutions for higher education as institutions deemed to be universities during the period from January, 2007 till date, the State-wise details of which are given below:
