- (a) whether the Government proposes to set up new Agricultural Export Zones (AEZs) throughout the country, particularly in West Bengal;
- (b) if so, the details thereof alongwith the funds allocated for the purpose;
- (c) if not, the reasons therefor; and
- (d) the status of implementation of each of the AEZs?

Answer

- (a to c) In the year 2004, the Government had set-up a Peer Review Committee to evaluate the performance of the existing Agri Export Zones (AEZs) & on the basis of its report, it has been decided not to consider setting up of new AEZs unless there are strong compelling reasons.
- (d) No new AEZs including West Bengal have been set-up in the country after 2004. The status of the existing 60 AEZs in 20 states as on March, 2010 is annexed at Annexure-I.
