(c) whether the Government has proposal to promote public-private partnership in the defence sector; and

(d) if so, the details thereof?

## Answer

## MINISTER OF DEFENCE(SHRI A.K. ANTONY)

(a) & (b): Presently, large percentage of military hardware is being imported. A number of steps are being taken to enhance the self-reliance in Defence production. The following measures have been taken to improve the R&D level:-

(i) Top down approach to initiate R&D within Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO), with academic institutions, other scientific bodies and with foreign collaborations.

(ii) Bottom up futuristic R&D through domestic and international collaborative research.

(iii) Close working with the three Services to forecast and develop systems indigenously through 'MAKE' procedures.

(iv) Joint development of major systems through international collaborations.

(c) & (d): Yes, Madam. Defence sector has been opened for 100% private sector participation and Indian private industries are now participating in the development and production of defence equipment.
