The UN has the primary responsibility for the safety and security of Peacekeeping Forces contributed by member states. UN peacekeepers are deployed only with the consent of the parties to conflict while ensuring their impartiality and non-use of force, except in self-defence. India provides adequate pre-deployment training to its troops and police personnel to ensure their effectiveness, safety and security.
