- (a) & (b) Up-gradation of existing laboratories and creation of new laboratories is a continuous and ongoing process. Recently, Government has set up three new food testing laboratories at
- (i) Raxual (Bihar) at Indo- Nepal border
- (ii) at Sonauli (U.P.) at Indo-Nepal Border and
- (iii) at Mumbai. Building of a new drug testing laboratory at Hyderabad has also been constructed.
