- (c) if so, the details thereof alongwith estimated cost of the said projects, funds released, expenditure incurred thereon; and
- (d) the time by which construction work is likely to be completed?

Answer

- (a): No, Madam.
- (b): Bridge over Gandak river which is a part of this new line project, is under progress.
- (c): The anticipated cost of the project is Rs. 378.56 crore. An expenditure of Rs.88.22 crore has been incurred on this project upto 31-03-10.
- (d): Completion would depend upon availability of resources.
