- (c): Scheme-wise Central allocation under various rural development schemes during 2010-2011 are given at Annexure.
- (d)&(e): The programme guidelines has provided an inbuilt mechanism to monitor the programme effectively. In addition, the existing monitoring tools also help to ensure that the benefits of such programmes/projects reach the target groups.
