- (c) the time by which the said line is likely to be completed?

(a) to (c): The Gauge conversion between Chhindwara – Seoni – Nainpur – Mandla Fort (182.25 Kms) has been taken up as a 'New Work" in Budget 2010-11 at an anticipated cost of Rs. 556.54 crore. The Project is in initial stages and outlay of Rs. 4 crore has been provided for in 2010-11. No target date for completion has been fixed yet.
