(a) The total number of foreign investors along with the amount invested in Telecom Sector during the last three years and the current year are as under:

(b) As per the extant policy, 74% composite (direct +indirect) Foreign Direct Investment (FD) is permitted in Telecom sector, out of which 49% is permitted through automatic route. The Government has revised the methodology of calculation of indirect foreign investment in February 2009, according to which FDI of less than 50% in the investing company is not counted in the telecom licensee company if the investing company is 'owned' and 'controlled' by Resident Indian Citizens. This change of methodology of calculation of indirect foreign investment from earlier proportionate basis to 'owned' and 'controlled' basis has given more room for further investment in the telecom sector.
