## Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

(a) whether there is a shortage and nonavailability of NCERT books in the market;

(b) if so, the details thereof and the reasons therefor; and

(c) the corrective steps taken by NCERT in this regard?

## Answer

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SMT. D. PURANDESWARI)

(a) to (c): According to National Council of Educational Research and Training (NCERT), there is no shortage of NCERT textbooks in the market. NCERT has anticipated a total requirement of 3.69 crore copies of textbooks for the academic session 2010-11 for the students of schools affiliated to Central Boards of Secondary Education. It has taken following steps for timely availability of textbooks in the market:

(i) NCERT has empanelled more than 340 wholesale agents throughout the country, out of which 70 are located in National Capital Region of Delhi itself.

(ii) The printing of textbooks has been outsourced to private printers empanelled by NCERT.

(iii) NCERT has hired godowns space from the Central Warehousing Corporation at Delhi, Noida, Shahibabad, Ahmedabad, Kolkata, Banglore and Guwahati.
