(a) & (b): While the University Grants Commission (UGC) has developed model curriculum in various subjects, according to information furnished by UGC, there is no policy to implement uniform syllabus across the country. The UGC is trying to augment teaching and learning through e-project with help of its Inter-University Centre [Consortium for Educational Communication (CEC)].
