- (a) to (d) The National Nutrition Mission was constituted vide Gazette Notification dated 31st July, 2003. Its main objective was to review the goals set out in the National Nutrition Policy 1993 and strategies adopted by various Ministries/ Departments besides coordinating their activities.
- (b) Subsequently the Prime Minister's National Council on India's Nutrition Challenges has been set up under the Chairmanship of the prime Minister vide Govt. Notification dated 31-10-2008 to provide policy directions, review the ongoing programme and coordinate between various Ministries to address the challenge of malnutrition in a more effective way.
