- (c) whether the Government has evaluated the rural development schemes that have been implemented by the States including Kerala and Bengal during the last three years, State-wise and;
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

- (a) & (b) :The Ministry of Rural Development has been regularly coordinating with the State Governments and Union Territory Administrations through various modes such as organizing of meetings of Performance Review Committee (PRC), visits of Area Officer's in the States/Districts, meetings of Vigilance and Monitoring Committee (V&MC) at the State/District Level, and visits of National Level Monitors (NLMs) in different districts to monitor the progress of rural development programmes.
- (c)& (d): During the last three years, the Ministry of Rural Development has conducted evaluation/impact assessment studies of its programmes namely Accelerated Rural Water Supply Programme (ARWSP), District Rural Development Agencey (DRDA) Administration, State Institute of Rural Development (SIRD). These studies covers all the major states in the Country, including Kerala and Bengal. Broadly, the reports have assessed the performance of various schemes as satisfactory.
