- (c) the areas identified by the Government where the merger had proved in effective; and
- (d) the remedial steps taken by the Government in this regard?

(a) to (d): Integration of both the companies have been completed in many areas like Board of Directors, Organisation structure, selection of leadership teams-Functional Directors, Executive Directors, some General Managers(holding independent charge), Customer Services, Integrated Material Management Policy, financial Synergies/quick wins in Insurance, Fuel procurement, Bank & fund management, common accounting policies, legal & tax issues, delegation of administrative and financial powers and integration of manpower upto the level of General Manager. In some other areas including Sales and Marketing, IT, PSS, ERP, Ground Handling, Human Resource, property and facilities etc., the integration process is underway. The process is being monitored closely by the Company's management, the board and at various levels in the Government.
