- (b) if so, the places where such services has been introduced;

MINISTER OF THE STATE (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) IN THE MINISTRY OF CIVIL AVIATION (SHRI PRAFUL PATEL)

- (a) and (b):Pawan Hans Helicopters Limited (PHHL), a Public Sector Undertaking (PSU) under the Ministry of Civil Aviation operates passenger services from Augustmuni to Kedarnath and Badrinath Dham twice in a year (May June and September October). PHHL also operates regular passenger services to Mata Vaishnodevi Shrine from Katra. PHHL has also started regular passenger services with effect from 01.07.2010 on Baltal-Panjtarni sector for Amarnath Dham.
- (c):Does not arise.
- (d):The above services introduced by PHHL have facilitated a large number of pilgrims in carrying out their pilgrimages.
