- (a) whether any proposal for repair of the forts Vijaydurga and Sindhudurga in Maharashtra has been received by the Union Government from the State Government of Maharashtra;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the funds allocated / being allocated by the Union Government for the repair of the above forts; and
- (d) the time by which the repair work of the said forts is likely to be completed?

Answer

- (a) & (b) Vijaydurga and Sindhudurga are the protected monuments of Archaeological Survey of India. While no such proposal has been received from Government of Maharashtra, the Maharashtra Tourism Development Corporation has requested the Archaeological Survey of India (ASI) to take up the conservation work at these forts.
- (c) The details of expenditure incurred during the last three years and allocation for the current financial year are as under:
