- (c) and (d):- No, Sir. However, Directorate General of Civil Aviation (DGCA) has issued a circular to institutionalize a mechanism at major metro airports including Delhi and Mumbai, wherein a team comprising representatives of Airports Authority of India, Airport Operator and airlines are working on daily basis to review reasons for lack of On Time Performance (OTP) in respect of flights operated the previous day. DGCA also monitors the On Time Performance of schedule airline on monthly basis.
