- (a) whether the cost of aviation turbine fuel has come down in the country since July, 2010;and
(b) if so, the details thereof and the extent to which this cost has been reduced and the reasons therefor?

(a)to(b): Aviation Turbine Fuel (ATF) is a decontrolled petroleum product. Accordingly, the price of ATF is reviewed and fixed by the Public Sector Oil Marketing Companies (OMCs) every fortnight on the basis of the international product prices. The details of the revisions made in the ATF prices by OMCs are as follows:
