Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government had sought funds from the Planning Commission for converting various stretches of National Highways into four-lane highways during the 11th plan period;
- (b) if so, the details including the quantum of funds sought and the amount actually allocated to the Ministry; and
- (c) the total length of National Highways targeted for conversion into four-lane during the said plan period and the actual achievement made so far, State-wise?

Answer

MINISTER OF THE STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS (SHRI R.P.N.SINGH)

- (a) and (b) The Ministry had proposed the fund requirement of Rs. 1,13,060.45 crore for the Central Sector Roads for the Eleventh Five Year Plan (2007-12) including funds for upgradation of National Highways (NHs) to four-lane standards. As against this, the outlay of Rs. 1,07,359 crore has been allocated for the Central Sector Roads.
- (c) The physical targets stipulated for upgradation of the NHs to 4-lane standards or more for the Eleventh Five Year Plan primarily pertain to expeditious completion of balance works under National Highways Development Project (NHDP) Phases-I & II, completion of first phase of NHDP Phase-III, strict monitoring of implementation of second phase of NHDP Phase-III and NHDP Phases-V (6-laning of 6,500 km). These physical targets have been fixed programme wise / NHDP phase wise and not State-wise. The year-wise details of annual physical targets set for the above mentioned programmes during the financial years 2007- 08 to 2010-11 vis-Ã -vis the achievements during this period are given below: -
