Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government/NHAI is planning to award 15,000 kms.of highway/road projects during 2010-2011;
- (b) if so, the details thereof, stretch-wise and State-wise;
- (c) the total investment required alongwith the proposed mobilisation of resources for the projects; and
- (d) the details of projects likely to be undertaken on PPP, BOT, other modes etc.?

Answer

MINISTER OF THE STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS (SHRI R. P. N. SINGH)

- (a) & (b) The Government / National Highways Authority of India (NHAI) have awarded 2692 km of length against the target of about 9000 km during 2010-11. The balance length is targeted to be awarded out of carried over projects from Work Plan–I and works identified under Work Plan–II, based on inter-se-priority, viability of projects and response from the bidders. The list of works is at Annex.
- (c) As per the financing plan recommended by the B. K. Chaturvedi Committee the estimated total investment is Rs. 9,35,139 crore proposed to be mobilized through cess funds, external assistance, net surplus from toll revenue, budgetary support, share of private sector and market borrowings for the construction of National Highway projects under various phases of National Highways Development Project (NHDP) up to 2014.
- (d) It is estimated that nearly 60% of the projects would be taken up on BOT (Toll), 25% on BOT (Annuity) and 15% on EPC basis.
