- (a): Yes, Madam.
- (b): The Central Tobacco Research Institute (CTRI) has conducted research on developing tobacco as an oil seed crop. In the study, it was observed that tobacco seed contains around 35% oil and refined tobacco seed oil is suitable for edible purpose.
- (c) & (d): CTRI has conducted research on other beneficial uses of tobacco and has developed an integrated approach for recovery of 95% pure solanesol, pure nicotine and organic acids from tobacco and tobacco waste and edible protein from green leaf.
