- (a): Yes, Madam.
- (b): Agriculture related extension activities for dissemination of information and knowledge amongst farmers include Trainings, Exposure Visits, Demonstrations, Kisan Melas, Kisan Goshties, Farmer Scientist Interactions (FSIs), Mobilization of Farmers Interest Groups (FIGs), Farm Schools and Use of Print & Electronic Media. Besides this, the infrastructure of Doordarshan and All India Radio is utilized to transmit programmes related to agriculture and allied sectors. In addition, information is disseminated through 25 Kisan Call Centres set up across the country which can be accessed by farmers from 6.00 a.m. to 10.00 p.m. on all days by dialing a toll-free telephone number 1800-180-1551.
- (c): Yes, Madam.
- (d): The details of the States/Union Territories where the Scheme `Support to State Extension Programmes for Extension Reforms` is operational are given in Annexure-I.
- (e): State-wise and year-wise details of allocation made during the last three years and current financial year are given at Annexure-II.
- (f): Over 112 lakh farmers have benefited under the scheme during last 3 years including about 27 lakh female farmers. State-wise, year-wise & gender-wise number of farmers who have benefited during the said period is given at Annexure-III.
