- (a) & (b): Yes, Madam. Production of certified/quality seeds has doubled from 140.50 lakh quintals in 2005-06 to 279.72 lakh quintals in 2009-10.
- (c) & (d): The State Governments are empowered under the Seeds Act 1966, Seeds Rules 1968 and Seeds (Control) Order 1983 to regulate the quality of seeds. There is no proposal to set up a Seed Control Authority.
