## Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of proposals received for promotion of organic farming from various State Governments including Madhya Pradesh, alongwith the expenditure involved therein;
- (b) the details of action taken thereon; and
- (c) the time by which funds are likely to be released to the States?

## **Answer**

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE AND MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF CONSUMER AFFAIRS, FOOD AND PUBLIC DISTRIBUTION (PROF. K.V. THOMAS)

- (a) & (b): Under National Horticulture Mission (NHM), 4 proposals amounting to Rs.2593.00 lakh have been received from Chhattisgarh, Gujarat, Maharashtra and Rajasthan for adoption and certification of Organic Farming.
- (ii) Under Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana (RKVY), 11 proposals from various States including Madhya Pradesh have been approved with an amount of Rs.11368.19 lakh.
- (iii) Under Horticulture Mission for North East and Himalayan States (HMNEH), 9 proposals for Rs.1191.20 lakh have been approved for NE States.
- (c): Under NHM, funds are released after the proposals are approved by the Executive Committee. Under RKVY and HMNEH, first installment of funds has been released already.
