- (e) the steps taken thereon?

(a) & (b): Yes, Madam. Ministry of Agriculture, Government of India has been implementing Horticulture Mission for North East and Himalayan States (HMNEH) to harness the potential of horticulture crops including saffron cultivation. Under the scheme, assistance provided to saffron growers during the last three years is as follows:-

- (c) to (e): Yes, Madam. Pattern of assistance has been enhanced w.e.f. 12-05-2010 to help and motivate saffron growers under the following major components:-
- (i) cultivation from Rs. 13000/ha to 60000/ha
- (ii) Tubewell/borewell from Rs. 12500 to Rs 1,03000/-
- (iii) Community water tank from Rs.10 lakh to Rs. 17.25 lakh
