- (a): The National Rainfed Area Authority (NRAA) was set up by Government of India in 2006 to ensure holistic and integrated development of Rainfed areas in the country. The Authority is presently serviced by Ministry of Agriculture. An outlay of Rs.123 Crore has been made for implementation of the activities of the Authority during the XI Plan.
- (b) to (d): The Authority is providing technical inputs at the policy level for the holistic development of rainfed areas in the country. The Authority has much broader mandate for sustainable development of rainfed areas of the country. The mandate assigned to NRAA is annexed.
